II. <u>Minutes:</u> Motion made by Mr. Barrett and second by Mr. Colameta to accept the minutes of the regular meeting of Tuesday October 6, 2021. Voice approved.

III. <u>Director's Report:</u>

In addition to the previously submitted written Executive Director's Report, the following information was provided. Mr. Kergo mentioned the Laundry Machine Bid for the elderly sites will be going out for a December Bid opening. Mr. Kergo had also mentioned that the year-end certification will need to be approved and signed by the end of November; and that the new budget is being prepared. The Executive Director also suggested for the next Board meeting to be scheduled no later than November 23rd, he asked the members if they would like our Fee Accountant, James Griffin to attend the next board meeting to discuss the year end and the proposed budget.
